Festive Enrichment Ideas for Horses & Donkeys

Winter often means more stabling, less turnout, and greater risk of boredom for our equine companions. A few simple enrichment activities can make a big difference to their wellbeing, encouraging natural behaviours and supporting calm, content horses and donkeys



Food-Based Fun

Forage Boxes Fill a shallow box with hay, chopped fibre, and a few safe treats (carrot, apple, herbal nuggets).

Slow-Feeders & Treat Balls Small-hole nets and floor-level feeders help extend eating time. Treat balls filled with low-calorie pellets provide gentle entertainment.



Physical Play

Equine-Safe Balls Durable balls designed for horses and donkeys offer playful pushing and rolling opportunities.

Mini In-Hand Courses Use poles, cones, or a simple winter "adventure trail" to create short, engaging walks when turnout is limited.

Scratching Pads Mounted brushes or scratch boards provide a safe outlet for natural grooming behaviour.

Sensory & Stable Enrichment

Stable Mirrors Shatter-proof acrylic mirrors can reduce stress and weaving, offering a sense of companionship—especially helpful for donkeys.

Scent Exploration Introduce safe scents like peppermint or chamomile on a cloth placed out of reach. A small, occasional change keeps things interesting.

Mounted Puzzle Panels Commercial stable toys with flaps or sliders encourage curiosity and problemsolving without frustration.

Social Enrichment

Grooming Time A few minutes of extra grooming can mimic mutual grooming and strengthen bonds.

Buddy Contact Even short periods of safe social interaction over a fence or stable door can boost wellbeing.

Safety First

Introduce new items gradually, supervise at first, avoid sugary treats, and check toys regularly for wear. Ensure nothing can tangle legs or catch halters.

A small amount of enrichment can brighten the winter months—an ideal seasonal gift for the horses and donkeys in your care.
