Careers: Equine Groom



An equine groom will either work free-lance for lots of people as needed, or on a yard, riding school, livery yard, equine hospital, stud, competition yard or, a charity such as World Horse Welfare.

Their role is caring for the horses or donkeys' daily requirements, including but not limited to; feeding, mucking out, turning out, bringing in, changing rugs, grooming and may also include exercising the horses.



The role requires caring individuals with good attention to detail, are competent handling horses and who are happy undertaking physical labour. There are no educational requirements for this role but, there are many different courses that can be undertaken to support this career path.
