The role also requires a regular evaluation of the service offered to clients and the budgeting of the practice.

They are also crucial in ensuring their practice meets the core standards set out by the Royal College of Veterinary Surgeons (RCVS) under the Practice Standards Scheme.



Practice Managers come from a range of different backgrounds, but are usually educated to degree level and are often veterinary professionals themselves.
