



Calves are the future of your herd!

How your youngstock are reared in the first few months of life will have a dramatic effect on maximising their potential when they join the milking herd

Heifers calving in at 24 months of age or younger will have a higher lifetime yield, survive longer in the herd and have better fertility throughout life than those calving later

Good nutrition and environmental conditions in the first 8 weeks of life have a massive impact on lifetime health and productivity due to metabolic programming - THIS CANNOT BE ALTERED AFTER THE FIRST 8 WEEK PERIOD
